1. CALL TO ORDER BY MAYOR

Present: Mayor Nancy Miller, Vice Mayor Mel Lindauer, Councilmember Michael Politis. Via phone: Councilmember Chris Conomos and Councilmember Richard Bryan.

2. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Consideration to request County of Volusia to declare mandatory evacuation for all addresses East of S. Atlantic Avenue

City Manager Kurt Swartzlander introduced Resolution 2022-Nicole in an effort to be proactive regarding the storm. The city is still recovering from Hurricane Ian and there is a lot of damage to the coast from the beach erosion. It is expected that this storm will also produce more beach erosion. CMBR Conomos was concerned about residents who are elderly that may not have the resources to evacuate. It was explained that the county had been notified and shelters would be ready to open if necessary. The City Manager explained that the Chief Building Official would be monitoring buildings at risk on a regular basis and there could be some that are declared unsafe. If that does occur, the owner would need an engineer's report to declare it is safe to return. The city would not be condemning any building. The entire council was in support of the resolution and hoped the County of Volusia would act accordingly.

VICE MAYOR MEL LINDAUER moved, seconded by COUNCILMEMBER CHRIS CONOMOS to Adopt Resolution Nicole and to declare mandatory evacuation for all addresses East of S. Atlantic Avenue.
